These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by DuPage County.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about March 24, 2016, DuPage County will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds, in accordance with the Disaster Relief Appropriations Act, 2013 (Public Law) 113-2, to undertake a project known as CDBG-DR-05 – Villa Park Green Infrastructure Improvements located along Washington St. from the end streets of Addison Rd. to Riverside Dr. Within this corridor, 4 separate projects have been identified to assist in reducing the chances flooding during periods of high precipitation. Although Washington St. has been recently resurfaced, a number of side streets in the corridor have deteriorating roadway pavement. Total CDBG-DR funding is estimated at \$1,000,000.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

DuPage County has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at DuPage County, Community Development Commission, located at 421 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton, IL 60187, and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the DuPage County, Community Development Commission, located at 421 N. All comments received by 4:00 p.m. on March 24, 2016 will be considered by DuPage County prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

DuPage County certifies to HUD that Mary A. Keating, in her capacity as Director of DuPage County Community Services (such position having been designated as a Responsible Entity Certifying Official under County Board Resolution DC-R-0344-15) consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to

the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows DuPage County to use Program funds.

### OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the DuPage County certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of DuPage County (b) DuPage County has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD at
