

REUSE AND RECYCLING DROP OFF SATURDAY, MAY 18, 9AM-1PM

The Reuse/Recycle Drop-Off list describes in detail all items that will be collected during Spring Sweep. Please note that no stains, solvents, cleaning products or pesticides will be accepted. Drop off is drive through, participants are asked to stay in their cars while volunteers unload recyclables at each staion along the route.

Please box or bag each type of recylable separately so items can be easily removed from your car by volunteers. Stations will be set up in the order below so please load your vehicle accordingly.

Station 1 - Working Bikes

Adult bikes in reparable condition; gently used kids bikes

Station 2 - SCARCE

Books in any condition including encyclopedias, text books, workbooks, & reference books. Retail or homemade CD's or DVD's and LP's

Station 3 - Simple Recycling

Used clothing & shoes in any condition, misc housewares and small appliances in working order

Station 4 - ReStore

Tools, hardware and building materials in good condition

Station 5 - VP Fire Department

Wheelchairs, walkers, crutches & canes

Station 6 - Scrap Metal

Scrap steel, aluminum & copper empty propane canisters and other scrap metal. NO appliances or water heaters

Station 7 - Epaint

Latex and oil based paints/stains will be accepted. FEE BASED SERVICE Latex: Qt: \$1/can Gal: \$3/can 5 Gal: \$10/pail Oil Paint/Stain: Qt: \$4/can Gal: \$8/can 5Gal: \$20/pail

Station 8 - Interstate Batteries

Car, marine and sump pump batteries

Station 9 - VP Lions Club

Used eyeglasses, hearing aids, ink cartridges, cell phones and chargers, metal (house) keys, soda/pop tabs, decorative lighting strings/wires (holiday lights)

Station 10 - Roy Strom

Corrugated cardboard, broken down flat NO CHIPBOARD and paper for recycling - NOT SHREDDING

Station 11 - VFW

Old, tattered and faded American flags

Station 12 - PA Crimson

Full & discharged fire extinguishers

Station 13 - Village of Villa Park

Computers (desktop, laptop, tablets), monitors, printers, mice, cables, keyboards, zip drives, scanners, fax machines, shredders, DVD/CD players, DVR's MP3 players, VHS players, video game consoles, digital cameras, camcorders, TV (no wood), convertor boxes, cable/satellite receivers, cell phones, answering machines, calculators & stero equipment

Station 14 - Document Shredding
