**RE: Twin Lakes Area Street Improvement Program  
Belden and Princeton Full-Depth Reclamation  
Driveway Access**

Dear Resident:

Construction of the **2015 Twin Lakes Area Street Improvement Program** is now well underway. Grinding of the existing pavement on most streets is complete. The contractor is now ready to begin a process known as Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) on Belden Avenue and Princeton Avenue. This work will take place on Belden from Yale to Ardmore and on Princeton from Armitage to Belden. The process consists of grinding the existing pavement and stone base and leaving the ground material in-place. The ground material will then be mixed with water and cement and repaved, resulting in a new pavement base. This pavement base will then be paved with a final surface layer of asphalt.

In order to facilitate the Full-Depth Reclamation process, residents will not have access to their driveways during the workday on Thursday, October 1 and Friday, October 2. We ask that you remove any necessary vehicles from your driveway by 6:00 AM on these days. You may park on other streets in the project area, where permitted, during this time. Parking will not be permitted on the sections of Belden and Princeton where the full depth reclamation work is taking place. Residents are also asked to ensure that vehicles remaining in their driveways on those days are not parked in close proximity to the street, as the FDR process will require sufficient space to complete. All residents should have driveway access again at the end of each workday.
