HISTORIC LANDMARK **c. 1890**



This Victorian house had been built in the late 19th century, and was originally located at 201 South York Street in Elmhurst, Illinois. In the early 1960's, the house and property were donated to Immaculate Conception Church by the mother-in-law of Thomas Lynch. The Church did not need the house but greatly appreciated the property, so the house was scheduled to be destroyed. Mr. Lynch decided to approach the Church on purchasing and moving the house. Mr. Lynch made a donation to Immaculate Conception and moved the house in two parts to the present location at Hill Street on lot 55 of Suburb Hill subdivision of Lot 2. This large house has been lovingly preserved by David and Carole Anne Colby, the current owners.
