## 1920 - "Baker House", 326 South Myrtle Avenue



The architectural style is a transition between Queen Anne and Tudor, with custom design elements present not typical of homes in Villa Park. It was featured in the promotional "1920 Glimpse of Villa Park" booklet to attract wealthy families to Villa Park. This prestigious house features an unusual lunette window located in the front peak. It is named the "Baker House" after its original owner who was the President of the Village of Villa Park from 1919 to 1923.
